The types and sources of data we collect 3.1 Basic Account Data When you set up an account, Valve will collect your email address and country of residence. You must also choose a user name and password. The provision of this information is required to register a Steam user account. During your account setup, the account is automatically assigned a number (the Steam ID) that is later used to refer to your user account without directly exposing Personally Identifiable Information about you. We do not require you to provide or use your real name for setting up a Steam user account. 3.2 Transaction and Payment Data To make a transaction on Steam (for example, to purchase Subscriptions for Content and Services or to finance your Steam Wallet), you may need to provide payment details to Valve to enable the transaction.
